Established in 1968, the Central Washington University Foundation is an independent, privately governed, non-profit corporation with the mission of supporting CWU. The CWU Department of University Advancement provides staff support for the Foundation, as well as outreach to alumni, corporations, and foundations.

CWU Foundation's fundraising efforts result in efficiencies and benefits for the university by:

1. Assuring proper stewardship of private gifts
2. Providing deft flexibility and responsiveness
3. Managing assets strategically
4. Engaging volunteers as informed advocates
5. Ensuring confidentiality of donor records

In the fiscal year of 2018, University Advancement awarded 787 scholarships totaling \$1,675,347 in support to CWU students. With 73.8% of degree-seeking students having received financial aid in 2017-18, financial support is crucial to the success of CWU students.

Employee Payroll Deduct

As an employee of Central Washington University, you have the opportunity to enroll in payroll deduct. This program allows you to choose a dollar amount to be deducted from each paycheck and support the fund of your choosing. There are many funds you can choose from, including funds that support student scholarships, student emergencies, and student food security.

To sign up for payroll deduct, log into your MyCWU account and click on the Employee tab along the top.

On the right-hand side of the page, under 'Employee Links,' click on **Payroll Deductions**. After clicking on **Add Deduction**, select **CWU Foundation** as the deduction and then fill out the rest of the information needed on the page.
