

Non-Resident Waivers for Online Students

The following waivers are available to non-resident students in either online <u>classes</u> or online <u>programs</u>. Final eligibility is determined by the Associate Provost.

- A. Students enrolled in online <u>"classes"</u> will receive a discount similar to the WUE (Western Undergraduate Exchange) waiver. Undergraduates & Post-baccalaureate students pay 150% of resident tuition. Graduate students pay 125% of resident tuition.
- B. Students enrolled in online <u>"programs"</u> are eligible to receive a discount equal to 100% of the non-resident differential. Undergraduate, Post-baccalaureate, and Graduate students pay 100% of resident tuition after the waiver is applied.
- C. General waiver requirements:
 - a. Undergraduates must have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA
 - b. Graduate students must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
 - c. Recipients of institutional aid must file the FAFSA.
 - d. No minimum enrollment
 - e. Students physically attending CWU campus locations are not eligible for the Non-Resident Online Waiver
 - f. Students enrolled in self-supporting programs are not eligible to receive tuition waivers. For example:
 - i. Continuing Education
 - ii. Career and Technical Education
 - iii. Occupational Education
 - iv. Higher Education degree program
