Shane L. Windmeyer, Train The Trainer Program Coordinator

Shane L. Windmeyer serves as the founder and coordinator of the STOP THE HATE! Campus Bias & Hate Crime Prevention Program for the Association of College Unions International. Windmeyer has worked in this role for the past four years to implement a series of hate crime prevention efforts on behalf of the Association.



Among such efforts, Windmeyer initiated and served as the project director for the STOP THE HATE! Campus Bias & Hate Crime Prevention Train the Trainer program. Several partnering organizations including the Anti-Defamation League; National Center for Hate Crime Prevention, Education Development Center, Inc.; National Gay & Lesbian Task Force; the National Center for the Prevention of Hate Violence; The Higher Education Center for Drug and Other Alcohol Abuse & Violence Prevention; and Tolerance.Org, A Project of the Southern Poverty Law Center comprised a work group to develop the curriculum and format for this STOP THE HATE! Campus Bias & Hate Crime Prevention Program.

Windmeyer continually works to promote diversity and to create a safe learning environment for all people on college campuses. One of the foremost educators today on issues of sexual orientation on campus, Windmeyer is the co-editor of three books, "Out on Fraternity Row: Personal Accounts of Being Gay in a College Fraternity," "Secret Sisters: Stories of Being Lesbian and Bisexual in a College Sorority," and "INSPIRATION for LGBT Students & Their Allies." He will also release two new books, "Out on Fraternity Row 2" in the Fall of 2005 and "Best of the Best Gay College Guide" in Spring 2005. Windmeyer founded and currently serves as coordinator of Campus PrideNet – A National Network for LGBT College Student Leaders and the Lambda 10 Project – National Clearinghouse for Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual Fraternity Issues. Both organizations' primary purpose is to support gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender members of the college campus community and to educate on issues of homophobia, biphobia, transphobia, heterosexism and genderism at colleges and universities.

Windmeyer has been a guest speaker on several hundred college campuses since the release of his first book and has presented at numerous educational conferences dealing with gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender issues on local, regional and inter/national levels. Windmeyer has been featured on IN THE LIFE TV for their Fall Season Premiere episode aired on PBS and his work has been the focus of national attention from the New York Times, TIME Magazine, and other national press.

Windmeyer graduated from Emporia State University with a bachelor's degree in Communication and received his masters degree in Higher Education and Student Affairs Administration from Indiana University.
