



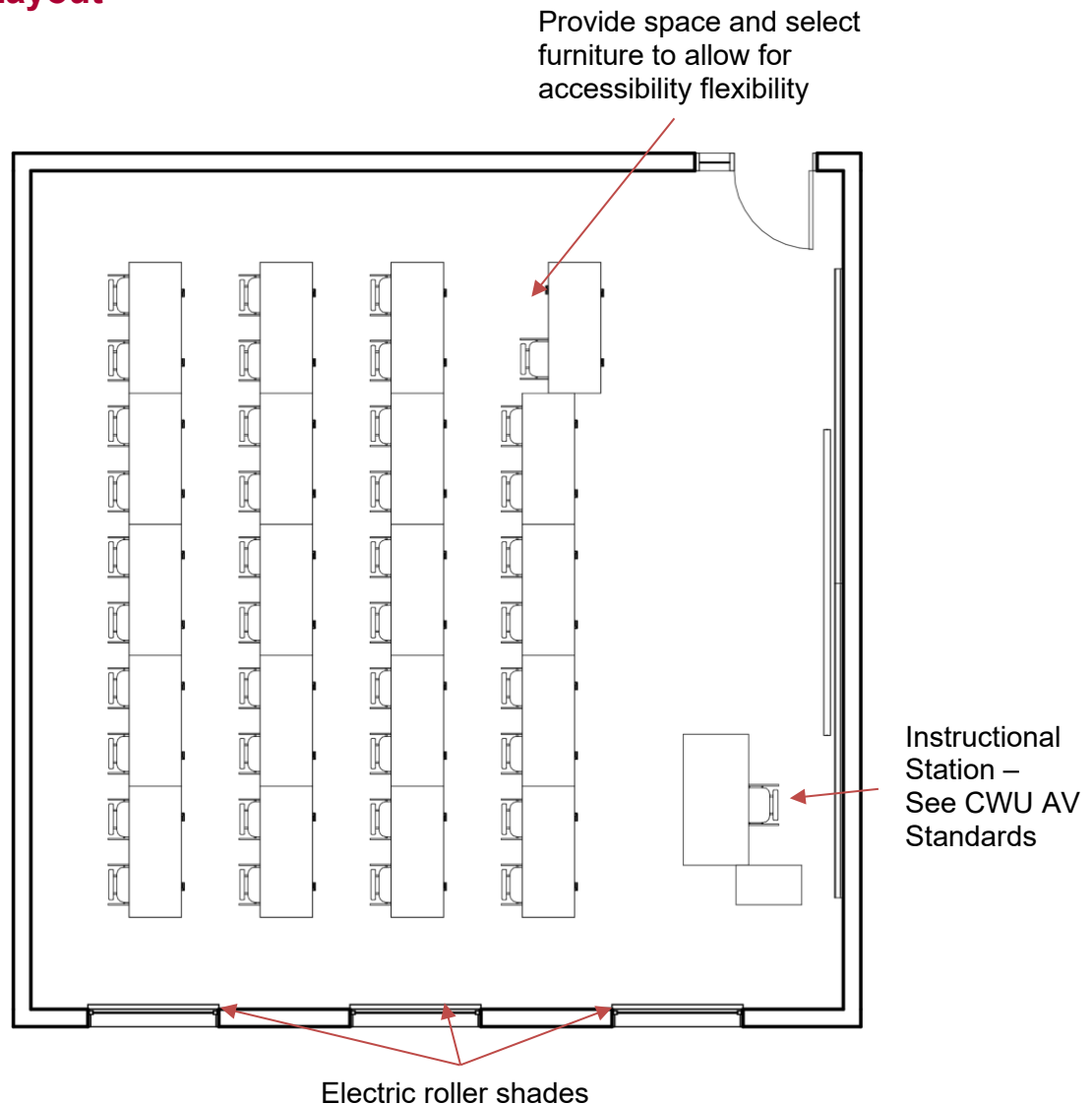

TYPICAL BUILDING SPACES

1 General

Classrooms that are not specialized are considered typical and are for general campus-wide use available to a variety of Departments. Typical classrooms are sized for 40 seats with some larger classrooms accommodating 50 seats. Lecture rooms with tiered seating may be required and those spaces are typically designed to accommodate 120 seats. Review with CWU project manager if rolling and/or nesting tables and chairs are desired.
