

Multimodal Learning

Multimodal Learning is the overall unit that provides faculty support and resources around teaching and learning. Multimodal Learning provides faculty with instructional technology and design opportunities. It also is home of the faculty-led Center for Excellence in Teaching and Learning (CETL) as well as the Multimodal Education Center (MEC).





The <u>Center for Excellence in Teaching & Learning</u> (CETL) focuses on faculty professional development around teaching and learning continuation, tenure, and promotion. Excellent teaching is required for continuation, promotion, and tenure, so learning hot to employ high impact teaching practices and culturally responsive instruction effectively and efficiently is essential. CETL faculty work together to build community, use evidence-based practices, and create transformative student learning experiences.

The <u>Multimodal Education Center</u> (MEC) provides short-term equipment check-out for students and other CWU community members. Additionally, the MEC partners with faculty who want to explore introducing emerging technologies into their teaching, research, and scholarship. For example, the MEC consults on the use of Virtual Reality (VR) in education, understanding and using generative artificial intelligence (e.g. ChatGPT), and Active Learning/Hybrid pedagogy in our Tech-Flex Classrooms in Samuelson. The MEC also assists faculty and student with digital production technologies such as animation, 3D scanning and modeling, and podcasting, while supporting audio/video recording and editing in the MEC Multimedia Studios. Lastly, the director of the MEC works closely with faculty in understanding their role and responsibilities in developing accessible learning materials and promotes the integration of Universal Design for learning in a variety of pedagogical strategies.

Instructional Technology and Design

Learning Management System: Canvas

CWU uses Canvas for the Learning Management System.

How Canvas Courses are Created: Canvas courses with student enrollments, are automatically populated 4 weeks before the beginning of each term, based on what is in MyCWU. Canvas is updated every morning. If you are added as the instructor of record to a course today, it will appear in Canvas tomorrow. If you do not see your course on Canvas, check your Faculty Center in MyCWU to confirm the course is there. If the course is not showing in MyCWU, contact the department admin about being listed as instructor of record.

If you would like a DESIGN course, not used for teaching but to build course content prior to the term, you can request one from Multimodal Learning.

Canvas Course Request Forms

Submit a course request from for the following types of courses:

- Request a Canvas DESIGN course
- Request to have <u>Canvas courses cross-listed</u>
- Request to separate auto-combined course sections
- Request an <u>independent study</u>, <u>practicum</u>, <u>or research course</u> (Courses that end in 90, 92)
