Essential programs and services will promote the veterans intellectual, cultural, emotional and physical wellbeing as they transform themselves to achieve their educational and career goals in and out of the classroom.

Mission Statement: The Central Washington University Veterans Center, together with the CWU Campus community, will create a seamless transition from boots to books in order to establish Central as the best university for veterans and their families.

As of 2013 we were able to integrate ourselves into the orientation program which has been a great success for our student population. We are able to communicate important/relevant detailed information to our students to assist them in their transition into a university. S&A funding was utilized to create orientation program materials.

We have created a tradition of celebrating our students success at an annual Graduation and SLAUTE Induction Ceremony. Graduating veterans are presented with a CWU specific challenge coin. SALUTE is a veteran national honor society where students are inducted into the ceremony and are presented with their certificate/challenge coin. In the 2015-16 year we were able to incorporate a guest speaker (Daniel Rodriguez) which was a success for our program as many of our students were able to relate to him.
