BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM, ACTIVITY, OR SERVICE

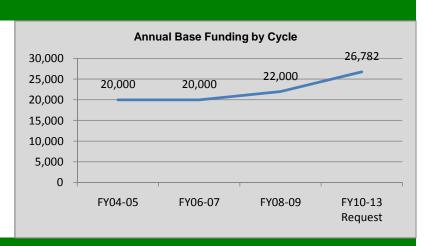

This project also serves to promote student involvement and awareness of the political process. Recently two activities have proven to be highly successful at involving students: the Washington Student Lobby chapter which allows for more involvement of CWU students in Olympia and the annual Lobby Day which will occur on the President's Day holiday. The Office of Legilative Affairs along with the Baord of Directors is also a member of the United States Student Association, which privides cwu students with leadership oportunities around the country.

The primary expense of the ASCWU Office of Legislative Affairs is the Legislative Liaison, who is a CWU student who spends winter quarter doing a full-time internship at the Capitol in Olympia.
