Student centered programming consists of annual events such as Welcome Weekend, Homecoming, Boo Central, Ware Fair, Family Weekend, Student Appreciation Day. Signature programs such as: Monday Movie Madness, Open Mic Nights, Concerts in the Pit, CWUp Late (late night programming), Comedy Nights. Some milestones experienced were: 30 Monday Movies with over 10,000 attendees. 15 Open Mic Nights with over 175 student performers and approximately 3,000 attendees. Concerts in the Pit with artists such as: Zach Hinson, Jasmine Jordan, Rust on the Rails, HAWAI Band, Nicole Lewis, performing to over 3,000 students, faculty, staff, community. With the aforementioned events (homecoming, student appreciation ,etc.) we confidently estimate nearly 30,000 students, etc. were positively impacted with the funding allocated to Campus Activities. Campus Activities also employed eight students and collaborated with the Public Relations and the Tourism, Recreation, and Event Management programs offering 3 practicum experiences totalling over 480 practicum hours and resulting in 12 credits hours for students.
