Some of the changes are fairly significant. No learner outcome changes for any courses. Two that add a layered course, but don't know where the courses are. CS 456 and CS 457. Mike Harrod indicated that the outcomes will be changed next year. The pre-req was changed from a B-requirement to a C requirement. Course type change to show more of what they are actually doing and update when they are typically offered.

#42 EDSE 411 - Assessment issue. This is okay

#43 EDSE 423 - Learner outcomes all say discuss, identify, analyze and apply.

#46 EDSE 432 - All the other proposals changed disabilities to exceptionalities. This should be the same. Three outcomes start with identify and appears low for a 400 level course.

#50 ENG 420 – This course changed from 300 to 400, but there is no change to learner outcomes. Demonstrate, explain and apply are fairly low level for a 400 level course. What they are really doing isn't the level they are actually doing. Needs to be strengthened.

#52 ENG 455 - Remove students will be able to. It is undergraduate course, but must be admitted to an MA program. This is a layered course and that language is for the 500 level course. Michael will make this edit.

#65 FCL 433 - Outcomes are out of date. A lot of identify and explain.

#66 FCL 434 - Outcomes are out of date. Understand concepts, understand how language.

#77 HTE 292 - This is place holder. Should they have outcomes?

#78 HTE 296 – Concern with outcomes.

#80 HTE 299 - Does this need to have outcomes?

#95-97 HTE 393M, 393N, 393Q - These should be different numbers.
