- 2. To fulfill this requirement three additional general education courses should be selected and completed from the following Knowledge Areas, with no more than one course per Knowledge area: Global Dynamics, Humanities, Individual & Society, Community, Culture & Citizenship, or Creative Expression.

Committee broke into sub-groups to review the sub-topics, sub-descriptions and activities for the first-year seminar proposals.
