Meeting was called to order at 3:08 p.m.

Chair update – Becky reported that the General Education website will be live on Thursday. Communications to students with 30 or less credits will also go out Thursday. The first Pathway Coordinators will be meeting on Wednesday at 4:00. Becky is working with Andre Dickerson to develop a student ambassadors group. Becky indicated she hopes to have a graduate assistant next year to work with the GE Director, Housing and Pathway Coordinators. There are two faculty advising workshops coming up. They will be April 18 & 24th from 2-3 p.m. Becky will be giving a short presentation at Faculty Friday, scheduled for April 26th.

184 Enrollment Strategy - Mike Harrod talked about the enrollment strategy from the associate dean/chair level. He expressed concerns about the GEC having management of enrollment. The committee discussed options. Jason suggested having some sections hidden until the other sections are filled, that way there would be sections open for first-year students. Becky gave the numerical data about potential scenarios with current vs incoming students. The committee did not make a decision, but will continue to work on this information.

Advising questions - Jason is working on an updated list and will work with Becky on those.

Policy 5-100-060 - The committee should write some procedures on how this will be done, so the expectations are clear. Laurie moved to change the word “meet” to “address” in 5-100-060 (3)(B)(1). Carey seconded and motion was approved. This will move forward to Faculty Senate for the May meeting.

The committee moved into sub-groups to continue the review of the in-direct transfer courses.

Laurie moved to approve the committee’s decisions regarding the in-direct transfer courses that are on page 1, page 2 to PHYS 100 and all of page 3. Jill seconded and motion was approved.
