There are concerns that open access journals are viewed as lesser or not as academic, and so faculty who publish in them may be negatively impacted when it comes to evaluations.

The following statement was developed at today's meeting:

An open-access journal is not necessarily an open-access journal. Faculty should be encouraged to publish in peer-reviewed journals. Publication in open-access journals should not be considered unfavorably in evaluation of scholarship.
