3. Chair Updates
  - I. Josh, Mel, and Eric met with Lydia Anderson, John Vasquez, and Iti Valverde to discuss student holds (Charge 2). There are variety of holds beyond academics. Gail recommended AAC should focus on academic holds and consider when it should be used, who can create them, and how to remove them students' accounts, otherwise, months could be spent on this charge. Lydia will provide a comprehensive list of existing holds (> 200) which are technically "service indicators."
  - II. Bob met with the Anti-racism, Diversity, and Inclusivity (ADI) task force. Bob's main concern was that too much is trying to be done beyond adding student credits to Gen Ed. The task force is still collecting feedback from all impacted constituents.

      - ii. Academic Suspension
        1. Students may petition suspension.
