- Charge 09. Honor Definitions and Honor Roll
- Charge 07. Disruptive Behavior Goal: Review the policy that AAC passed last year. I'll invite reps from Student Success to discuss concerns at our next meeting.

5-90-40-(24) Honor Roll

Rose SB explained the changes to the policy. Adds quarterly to make it clear that honor roll is a quarterly thing. And then it adds clarification that only graded courses are calculate for honor role.

We discuss the pros and cons of lowering honor role to 10 credits to make it more inclusive and encourage more students.

The other changes to policy clarify to match current practice.

Bob moves to approve. Mel seconds. 5 yes. One abstention.

5-90-50-8 (Gradating with honors)

- 1: Adds junior or senior standing to show that they have to be upper classmen for honors.
- 3: Adds a line to make it clear that the credits have to be earned at CWU.

We discuss the pros and cons of giving commencement honors recognition to students walking in Spring but graduating in Summer or Fall.

Need to include the commencement committee and Lauren Zeutenhorst on this. Also want to ask someone from the school of ed. Josh will ask Ian Loverro.
