#13 FIN 480 Portfolio Analysis and Management – The course description is missing a punctuation at the end. The learning outcome verbs seem low for a 400 level course. Understand or know are not good to utilize in the learner outcomes as well. Ben

#23 SCM 460 Digital Supply Chain Technologies and Application – There were two typos. First appears in the course description where the word "supply" is repeated twice in a row. Learner outcome says employ a basic simulation... is missing the word "to" and "were". Ben

Ben moved to send out new courses for campus review. Wendy seconded and motion was approved.

Program Changes

#14 Graduate Management Accounting Certificate – FIN 570 is being reactivated and not at the FSCC step yet. Discussion needs to be had by the committee on how much change can be made before it is a new program. Nearly everything is being changed on this proposal.

#16 Master of Professional Accountancy – There is a course that is being made inactive and not yet at FSCC that is listed in the program. Need to ask department if it is okay to remove that course.

#15 Health and Physical Education, MS - HPE 550 has not been approved by FSCC yet. (Updated: this course was approved by the committee at the March 17, 2022 meeting.)

#28 Teacher Certification – Waiting on course proposals.
