Faculty Senate decided not to support the Interstate Passport transfer system at this time.

The Antiracism, Diversity and Inclusivity Task Force would like to meet with GEC members about their work? The committee decided that they would like to meet with the ADI Task Force at the November 1st meeting.

Teri went over the General Education Program Goals & Component Areas & Elements sheet with suggested changes. The committee is okay with creating General Education program level outcomes. The committee would like additional GEC input on Goal placement. Need to come up with a title and description.
