AIS 184 – Moving from COTS prefix to the AIS prefix. They did not include a syllabus. Teri will request a syllabus.

HTE 184 – Changing description. A.I. moved to approve HTE 184 description change. John N seconded and motion was approved.

LLAS 302 – Proposed for K2 – No alignment for General Education learner outcome #2.

STP 406 – Proposed for CE.

Bret Smith is the Assessment Coordinator. Bret has been working with a number of different departments across campus. He has also been attending conferences and workshops around assessment. Other institutions are starting to utilize Canvas as a major part of their assessment process. Bret has done 3-4 pilot studies to test the process.

Dan Martin is the General Education Assessment Coordinator – Dan has been working with department chairs and sending communications on what General Education assessment requires. Working on some

of the forms and he will be helping departments complete the forms to gather the data. General Education assessment email needs to be set up.
