#2 ART 450 Advanced Drawing - Outcomes language is not consistent. Need to remove "students will". Communicateusing correct vocabulary. #2 Outcome doesn't use parallel language to the other outcomes "Students will use correct vocabulary to communicate theoretical concepts of drawing"

#7 ASP 450 Media Portrayals of Disability – Outcome #1 seems like there is a typo. Analyze complex identify, maybe should be identity. Kurt will check with originator. #7 Outcome 1 "Analyze complex identify issues including intersectionality of accessibility and other personal characteristics." Kurt indicated that he has confirmed with the originator that "identify" should be "identity".

#9 ASP 492 Advanced Practicum in Accessibility Studies – There was a comment from Gail Mackin regarding this proposal. Kurt will ask if this has been addressed.

#12 CTE 405 CTE Exit Assessment – Description and reason for change. Removing a pre-requite. They say we are removing a pre-requisite as part of their justification. Should they give more information. Kurt will check.

#22 WINE 408 Advanced Sensory Analysis – Strengthen learner outcomes or streamline them. #2 and #3 have unnecessary preamble language.

#14 PHYS 331 Laboratory Practices and Techniques may have contact hour issues.

#15 PHYS 333 Experimental Physics I may have contact hour issues.

#18 SHM 351 Incident Analysis may have contact hour issues. #14, #15 and #18 will be talked about more about when the committee gets to policy/procedure.

#3 ART 479 Methods and Theories of Art History –#3 Outcome has a subject-verb agreement issue and could be "integrates", currently written as "Write a research paper that integrate history, formal analysis, and contemporary scholarship in order to develop original scholarship."

#6 ASP 430 Reasonable Accessibility Accommodations – Typo in displayed co-requisite. Missing one of their "u" in successful.

#13 HIST 459 Childhood and Youth in African History – Layered course normally same number. HIST 459 and layered with course HIST 549. Is this a rule for layered courses? This could be a typo. HIST 459 the 500 layered cannot be 549, as that number is already occupied. This numbering is correct as the department already has a 559.

#16 SCED 520 Makerspaces for STEM Teachers – Course doesn't have any pre-requisites. SCED 520 went to grad curriculum council but was not viewed by its members and was deadline was automatically approved at the deadline.
