



# Have you ever been a department chair, or a member of a department or college personnel committee at CWU?





# **Personnel Committees Only-** When reviewing SEOIs for evaluation, do you primarily use the long or short form?





SEOIs should be used only in a formative fashion.





**Personnel Committees & Faculty-** Summative assessment is intended to give a final verdict. Summative assessment says "this is deficient" or "this is acceptable." Summative assessment answers the question "is this teaching inadequate, acceptable, or excellent?" Summative assessment can show knowledge and skills demonstrated on tests after instruction.


SEOIs should be used only for summative assessment.


