Call to order

Tech Fee Request- Vicki Sannuto: Career Services: \$44,000 for software

Vicki is requesting two types of technology. The first is software for the Wildcat Career Network, it was initially \$20k per year, but it is now 15K. Career Services have been using this software for years and it has worked great. The second is for software for a program called Career Plus, this costs 24k for 6 career fairs. This has a mobile app where students can connect with employers and set up meetings. Due to covid, the department lost out on money from career fairs and do not have the funds to support these two programs for the upcoming year, however, they hope to take over the funding again once things get back to normal. Vicki is going to email Bea usage statistics and a PowerPoint that did not load during the meeting. The council will vote on this request once they receive that information. The total for both technologies is 39k, Vicki did not specify which software was more important, but indicated she would be grateful to have either funded.

Tech Fee Request- Chad Schone: Multimodal: 40 chrome books

The multimodal department would like to have 40 chrome books to distribute among the centers. All of the centers have the wireless internet capabilities to support the chrome books, but Des Moines might be an issue. Stacy is checking with the networks team to double check.
