Eligibility: Financial Need (FAFSA/WASFA), History Major, US Citizen, 3.0 GPA or higher.

Requirements: 500-word or shorter typewritten statement describing applicant's academic qualifications, including cumulative GPA, as well as specific historical interests and accomplishments.

PAUL E. LEROY HISTORY SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility: History Major, 3.0 GPA or higher.

Requirements: List of three references in the History Department at CWU who are familiar with the applicant's work; list of honors and awards; unofficial transcripts; one page essay that includes a statement of why they are studying history and how they meet the selection criteria, including an indication of financial need.

NANCY AND BEN REMAK HISTORY SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility: History Major, Enrolled at the Ellensburg campus, 3.5 GPA or higher.

Requirements: 500-word or shorter typewritten statement describing applicant's academic qualifications, including cumulative GPA, as well as specific historical interests and accomplishments; two letters of recommendation (one should be from a History Department faculty member).

C. FARRELL FINE ARTS AND RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility: 3.0 GPA or higher, Sophomore standing, conduct a specific research project in history of the Kittitas Valley, secure faculty sponsorship for the project.

Requirements: 400-600 word statement that describes the intent of your project; time schedule; project budget; two letters of recommendation (one by your faculty sponsor of the project, the other letter addressing your scholastic/creative ability, character, and the likelihood of successful project completion.
