What is it?

A regional undergraduate and masters-level history conference where students present their original research to a supportive audience and get feedback from regional faculty.

Why do it?

It's a great opportunity to present your research alongside your peers from other colleges and universities. We will travel together from Central and support one another as you gain professional experience and exposure to research and programs at other institutions. Also, Dr. Ferrell will review and offer feedback on your writing and presentation so you can feel more confident with your material before you present it.

How do you join us?

1. Submit an abstract of up to 200 words briefly explaining the central question(s) and time period(s) examined in your paper to Dr. Ferrell by February 4.
 - Include a title
 - Include your name, institution, and status (undergraduate or graduate)
2. Submit a paper of up to ten pages (not including title page, endnotes, and bibliography) to Dr. Ferrell by March 10.
 - Title page should include student name, paper title, institution, chapter name (if PAT member), and student status (undergraduate or graduate)
 - Paper should be double-spaced in 12-point font with 1" margins

Presenters are not required to be members of their local PAT chapter, but only members are eligible for awards.
