

Through the Empress's Wardrobe: Power and Style in 19th Century Russia is a museum exhibit curated by CWU Master's student Naomi Whiting (History). Near the turn of the 20th century, Russia was undergoing revolutionary cultural and social changes that threatened the status and authority of the imperial court to rule. During this historical moment, the clothing choices of the women of the Russian imperial court were deliberate—showing off wealth, status, and a deep connection to Russia's past. Visitors to this exhibit will be able to view faithful reproductions of the clothing of Empress Maria Feodorovna, who strategically used fashion to navigate Russia's complicated political dynamics.
