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Choose a Topic

Think of a research topic, hypothesis, theme, style, etc. to start your project.

- Conversations with your faculty/mentor
- What are you interested in learning more about?
- What inspires you?
- What are you good at?
- What are you thinking about doing post-graduation?

Develop a Project

Work with your faculty mentor throughout all stages of your project.

- Where to start
 - Choose a topic with your mentor
 - Scientific method, creative inspiration/concepts
- Background information, method, results, conclusion
- Artistic process, trial & error, versions of your piece(s)
- Progress student-mentor relationship
 - Networking success guide

SOURCE Abstract

Submit your project for SOURCE with a brief abstract or artist statement outlining your project.

- No more than 250 words
- Prepare with your mentor ahead of time for a successful submission
- **2024 Abstract Submissions Open: March 1–April 14**
