

TEACH Grant/Loan Instructions

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program provides funds to students who are completing or who plan to complete coursework that is required to begin a career in teaching, and agree to teach full time for at least four years at an elementary school, secondary school, or educational service agency that serves students from low-income families and to meet other requirements. At CWU, we call the TEACH funds, the TEACH Grant/Loan as a visual reminder to recipients of the requirements that they have agreed to fulfill and the results for failure to do so.

If a student does not fulfill the service obligation, the grant is converted to a loan with retroactive interest from the date of first disbursement.

Read the following instructions regarding the TEACH Grant/Loan. Steps must be done in this order, please plan accordingly for processing time:

- Step 1: Complete TEACH Grant Initial and Subsequent Counseling
- Step 2: Email completed application to financialaid@cwu.edu annually
- Step 3: Monitor your CWU email for application approval/denial (can take 1-2 weeks)
- Step 4: Monitor your CWU email for offer notice and Accept/decline TEACH Grant/Loan in your MyCWU
- **Step 5:** Monitor your CWU email for communication that Agreement To Serve or Repay is ready to be completed (can take 1-2 weeks)
- **Step 6:** Complete TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement)
- **Step 7:** Complete exit counseling before graduating, after you stop attending CWU or if you switch to a non-eligible major. If you do not, the grant will convert to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized loan with retroactive interest.

This application must be submitted to CWU each year that you would like to be offered the TEACH Grant/Loan. If you have any questions, please email financialaid@cwu.edu or call 509-963-1611
