Executive Board Report:

- **Chair: Spencer Biallas:** This week, I had a meeting with Richard Deshields, the Associate Dean of Student Living, in which we spoke about the culmination of information I have gathered regarding sexual assaults on campus. We are going to be implementing a couple of avenues to gain efficiency when addressing this issue. One of which will be providing an electronic prompting on each student's computer once they log on to their CWU account. The other will be provided through the Wellness Center on their web page, which will be a flowchart that walks students through the process of what they will be experiencing when addressing any specific scenario. All of these efforts push for students to gain awareness of sexual violence; we felt as though this will provide resources to educate people about these issues in an efficient, effective way. Julianne Behar, our liaison with WSA and I spoke and are working to bring this up to the Council of Presidents, in order to streamline this movement across the state. Minute to Win It was also yesterday, we had a great time, so, thank you to all who came out and participated in that. Also, regarding recognition packets, 3 Mondays from now, which is June 1st, everyone will need to attend the Student Government public meeting, which is at 6:00 in the SURC Pit.
