The managerial economics specialization can be used as part of a double major. See your advisor for details.

#### **Admission Requirements**

- **Minimum Grade of "C-" (1.70) in ENG 101 and 102**
- **30 Credits** – Complete in first 2 or 3 quarters
- **2.25 Collegiate GPA** – This is your CWU/Transfer Combined GPA on your Academic Requirement Report
- **Good Academic Standing the quarter prior to admission** – 2.0 quarterly GPA and 2.0 cumulative GPA
- **Meeting with an Economics Faculty member\***

\*Students applying for an Economics major must meet with an Economics faculty member and are highly encouraged to attend a College of Business, New Student Orientation. Economics Faculty advisors are located in Shaw Smyser, fourth floor.

### Additional Graduation Requirements

#### **Minimum GPAs and Grades**

- 2.25 GPA average for all major courses
- Minimum C- in each course (credit/no credit cannot be used for major courses)
- 2.25 Collegiate GPA (CWU & Transfer GPAs combined)

#### **Transfer Students**

- Must complete at least 45 credits at CWU
- Must complete at least 45 credits used in their major at CWU
