Ginny moved to approve the agenda. Coco seconded and motion was approved.

New programs

Bruce moved to put #1 Captive Primate Care; #2 BA Dance; #3 BS Sport Management; #4 BS Sport Management: Sport Business Specialization; #5 BS Sport Management: Sport Coaching Specialization, #6 BS Sport Management: Physical Activity and Recreation Programming Specialization. Coco seconded and motion was approved.

Program changes

#11 BS Family & Consumer Sciences Career and Technical Education Teaching - they are dropping PSY 447 and didn't see anything about Psychology being notified.

#8 Event Management minor - does not have strikeout copy. They need to clarify the justification. Hold minor until RTE 492 comes through.

#7 Dance Performance Minor – The justification is weak justification

New courses -

Bruce moved to put #19 RTE 162 and #24 RTE 340 on the log. Coco seconded and motion was approved.

#12 ADMG 476 - Are these duplicates of other courses? These are all electives. Not clear how these are separate courses. Course is okay.

#13 ADMG 477 - Outcomes appear low for 400 level course. Course is okay.

#14 ADMG 479 – Same as 476 and 479. Course is okay.

#15 DNCE 450 – Should this course be a 495 as a practicum. Outcomes are limited for a 400 level course.

#16 FCL 355 - Are outcomes strong enough for 300 level course? Outcome #2 is not related to course. Course is okay

#17 MIS 446 - Outcome #3 & 4 are not measurable.

#18 RTE 161 - Limited learner outcomes even for a 1 credit course. Description has more information than the outcomes.

#20 RTE 163 - Justification is circular. Typo in outcome and Rose will fix.

#21 RTE 210 - More facilitation than leadership. They have a program that hasn't been approved yet. Outcomes are more like tasks. Not clear what it is leadership in. Is it a field experience or practicum?

#22 RTE 294 - Sounds like credit for volunteering and community service. Could be duplicate for some of the LEAD courses.

#23 RTE 339 - Outcomes are low level for 300 level course. Course is okay.

#25 RTE 345 - Learner outcomes need to be strengthened.

Bruce moved to put #12 -14, #15 (pending new practicum # and outcomes), #16, #17 - 18 (pending revised learner outcomes), #20 (pending receipt of clarification of justification), #21-22 (pending learner outcomes), #23, #25 (pending learner outcomes) on the log. Michael seconded and motion was approved.
