Meeting was called to order at 3:11 p.m.

Gen Ed Redesign - Amy handed out the program level goals. The Task Force is still taking feedback. This will go before Senate on November 30th. The committee discussed the current version of the Redesign program goals and assessment.

Course substitutions – The committee suggested that we need to send the foreign language requirements to the department chair for review. Also need to send the Douglas Honors College requirements to DHC.

The committee talked about the current process for Associate degrees that if a student is within 2 courses it is considered that they have met requirements.

Gave permission to go ahead and discuss with appropriate departments some of the course substitutions to see if they are still relevant.

Course pre-requisites – The committee discussed the Physics 111 course and the current issue with a pre-requisite that has been added.
