

## Recreation, Tourism and Events-Event Management Specialization 4 Year "Sample" Graduation Plan

This plan should be used in conjunction with other advising forms that indicate frequency of offerings. Generally, core requirements are offered two or three quarters of the year, and specialization requirements are offered once a year. Electives are generally once a year, or even biannually. The RT major does not require a minor. Students who wish to take a minor should decide as early as possible and discuss scheduling with the major advisor.
