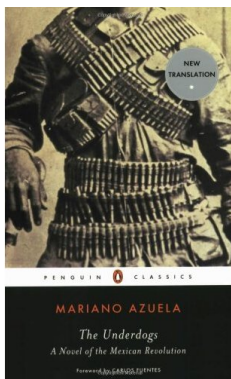

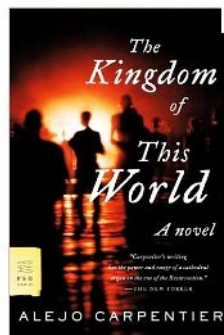

- global capitalism and indigenous rights

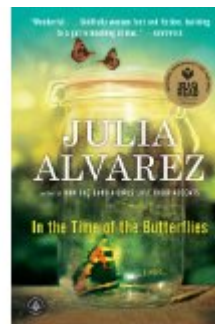

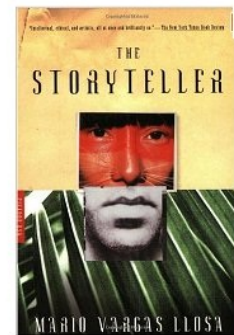
