1. This document does not substitute meeting with your advisor. See the current Edmonds Community College (EdCC) catalog for complete degree requirements.
2. Transfer to the Information Technology and Administrative Management (ITAM) program at CWU-Lynnwood with any Edmonds Community College applied or technical degree. While working to complete the requirements for the professional/technical degree, students may also complete several CWU Basic Skills requirements by taking equivalent classes. ENGL& 101 and one of the Math courses is recommended before applying to CWU.
3. Students may transfer a maximum of 135 total credits from regionally accredited four-year universities, including a maximum of 105 credits from regionally accredited community colleges.
4. CWU Transfer Policies and Course Equivalencies can be found at www.cwu.edu/registrar/transfer-equivalencies-policies.
5. You must earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.3 in the applied or technical degree.
6. Work with an EdCC advisor to ensure proper course sequencing for the applied/technical degree and BAS-ITAM major.
