

International Admissions Supplemental Form for Dependents

Dependents are defined as a student's spouse or children. A dependent does not include members of the extended family or parents.

If you have a dependent **whom you wish to bring with you to the United States** you must submit the following information with your Confidential Financial Statement and application to Central Washington University.

- 1. The full legal name of the dependent(s).
- 2. Their date(s) of birth.
- 3. Their gender.
- 4. Their relationship to the student.
- 5. Proof of ability to pay for the dependent. For children 0-2 years of age there is no additional cost. For children 3+ and adults you need to add an additional \$5,000 to the total academic year costs. The bank statement must prove ability to pay for these additional costs.

6. Copies of both the student's passport and the dependent's passport.

☐ Yes, I have a dependent(s) that I plan to bring with me to Central Washington University. I understand that I must submit all required documents and be admitted to Central Washington University before a dependent I-20 can be issued.

note: All dependents will be required to apply for F2 visas. F2 visa holders are not allowed to attend school unless they are children attending K-12. When a child turns 21 they no longer qualify for a F2 visa and must apply for a change of status or return to their home country. In addition, F2 visa holders are not allowed to work while in the United States.
