

The Teaching & Learning/Professional Development Work Group has moved forward with a Faculty Development Center space and IT proposal.

We have secured Samuelson 165 as a venue for the center. Samuelson 165 will provide both office and small workshop space for faculty development. The center will have capability to connect to center faculty using Skype for Business.

A number of faculty learning communities are in development that will begin to offer faculty workshops and brown bag talks throughout the 2018-2019 Academic Year. These groups are organized around the following topics:

- Critical Thinking Pedagogies
- Engaged Teaching Pedagogies
- Equity in the classroom and faculty relations
- Multimodal technologies and classroom strategies
- Curriculum Development
- Mentoring
- Student Advising
- Teacher-Scholar
- Service Learning
- Grant Funding
- Faculty Resources

The above faculty development groups will organize workshops and brown bag lunches around their respective themes throughout AY2018-2019.

Next years' Faculty Development program is currently under development along these themes. There is also a Faculty Development website, which is currently under development and will be available for faculty beginning of fall 2018. The website will offer the schedule of the year's faculty development events along with an accessible archive or recorded workshops held throughout the year.

In addition workshops organized by the themed-working groups mentioned above, the following workshops will be specifically intended for new faculty:
