- Spring 2013: 1-year Canvas contract signed and pilot begun

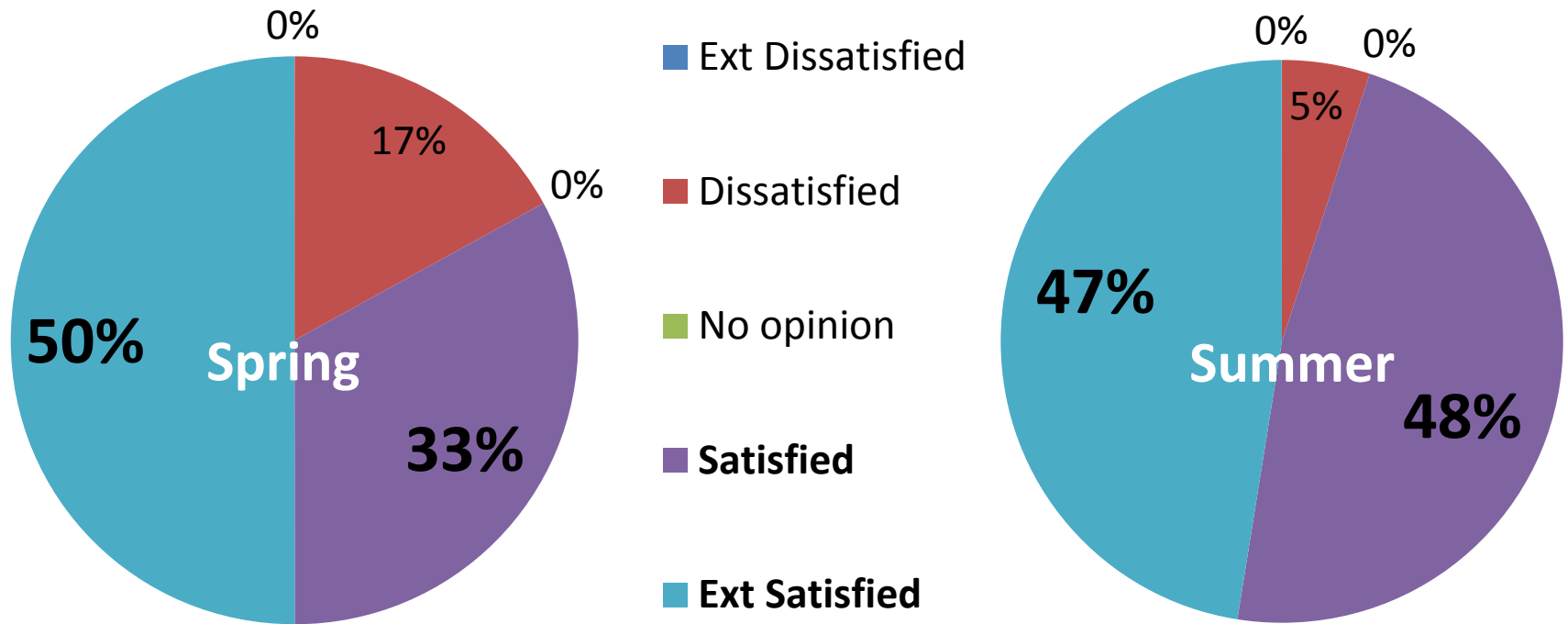

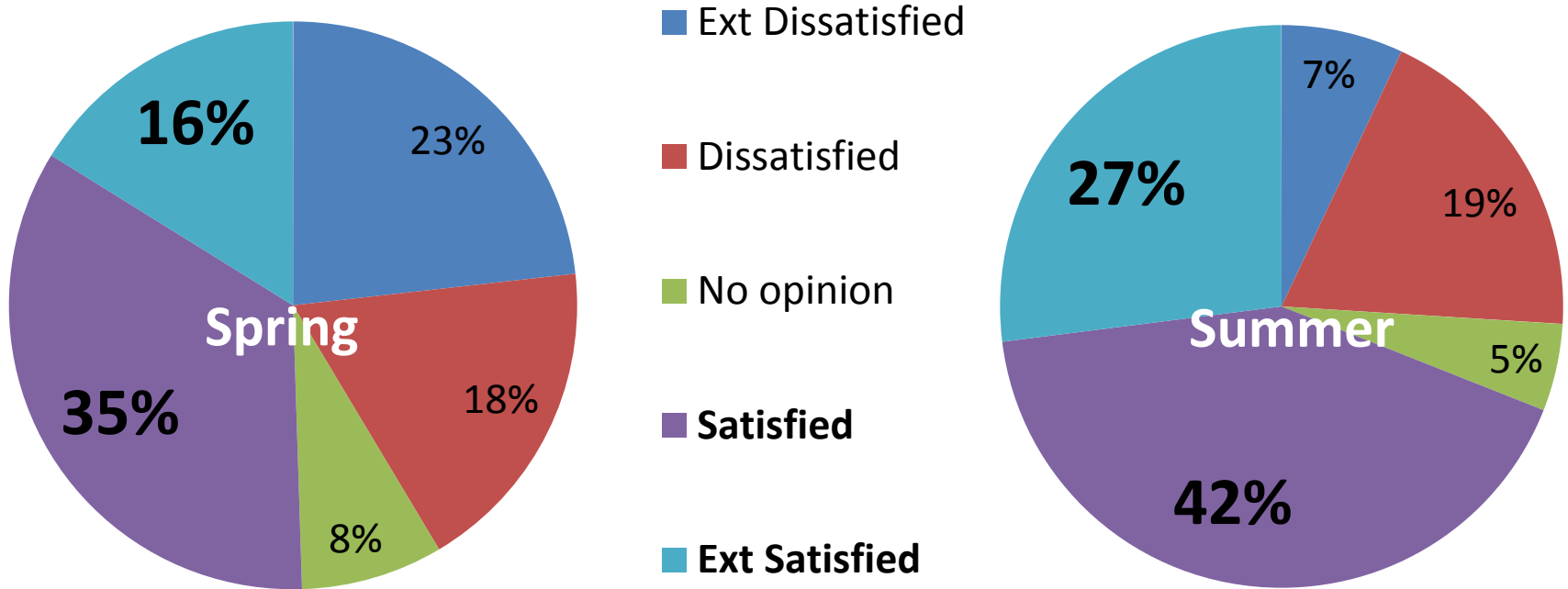
Overall Satisfaction with Canvas

Satisfaction Surveys: Student Overall Satisfaction with Canvas

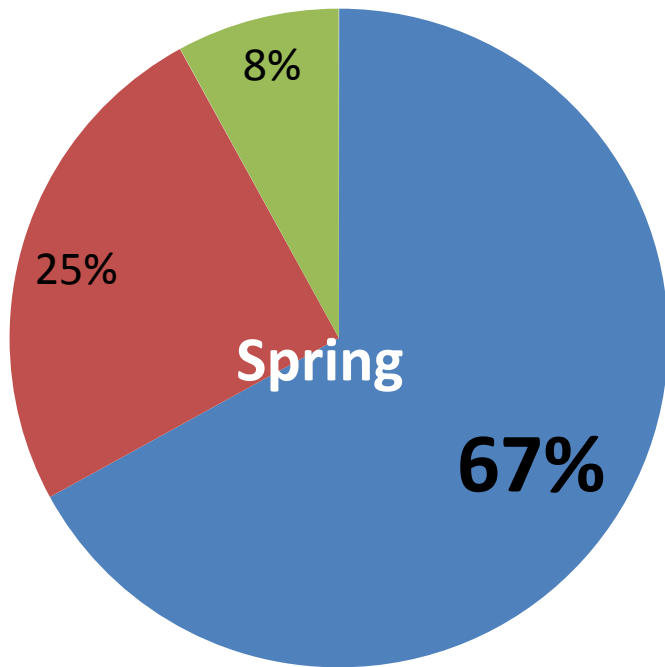

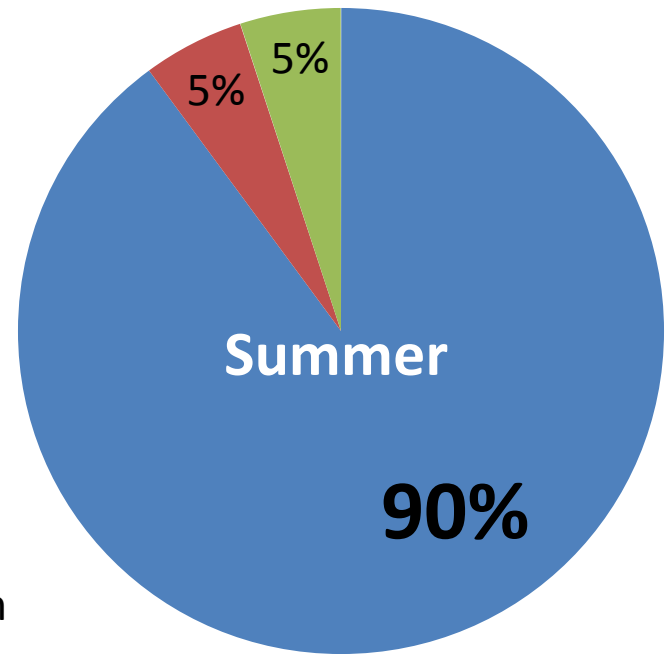
Recommend Canvas to Replace Blackboard

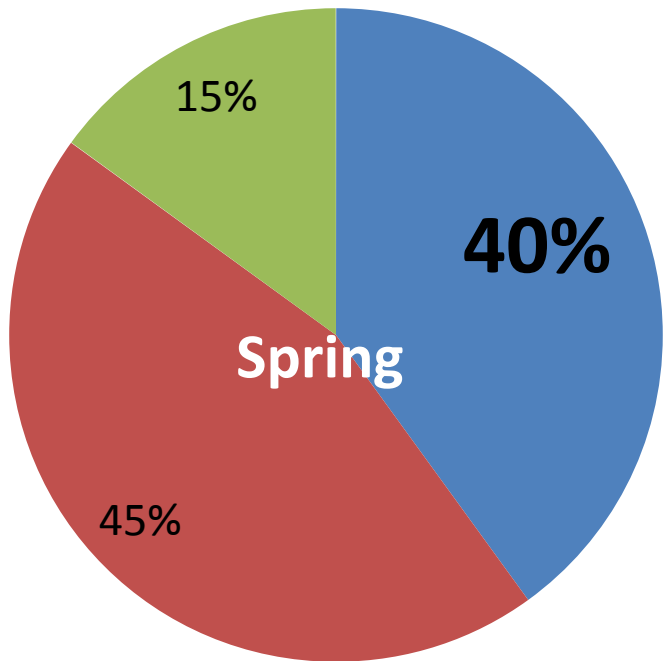

Summer (19/40 – 48% Response)

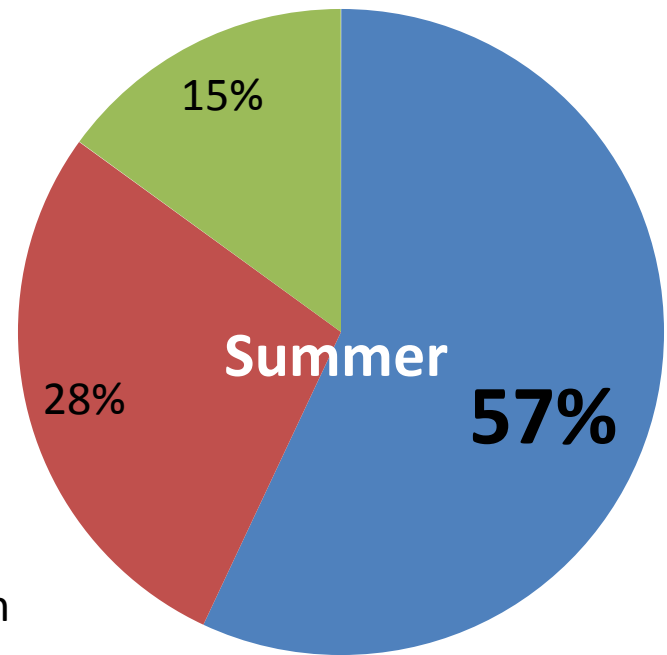
Satisfaction Surveys: Student Recommend Switch to Canvas

Preferred Features of Canvas

- Ease of navigation
- User-friendly interface
- Notifications: email, text message, social network
- File preview: embedded in page (no download)
- Calendar: linked to syllabus, assignments
- SpeedGrader: preview, rubric, grade, inline comments
- External Integrations: Web 2.0 apps
- Audio/Video: for discussions, assignment feedback

Functional & Technical Issues

- Interface Less Customizable
- Discussion Board Less Robust
- Notifications Lack Instructor Control
- Cloud-Based Software as a Service
- New Releases every 3 Weeks
- Single Sign-on through MyCWU Portal
- Outages and Slowdowns
