Multimodal Learning Faculty Fellow
Application for Academic Year 2022-23**

Multimodal Learning (ML) is currently accepting applications for the AY 2022-23 Multimodal Learning Faculty Fellow. This position is for 9-workload units and the primary duties include participating in instructional design team consultations and peer mentoring for faculty designing and teaching online/hybrid courses; evaluating new instructional technologies to recommend to faculty; facilitating and attending Multimodal Learning Community (MLC) meetings; creating presentations/tutorials on various topics to be delivered through faculty training workshops, MLC meetings, and the ML website; evaluating individual online courses using quality assurance rubric; training and supporting departments in using rubric for faculty peer reviews; and adding to available ML resources including online resources, book reviews, recordings, case studies, etc. as appropriate. (Specific workload assignment dependent upon discussions with the department chair and dean.)

Eligibility:

Full-Time Non-Tenure-Track, Tenure-Track, and Tenured faculty members are welcome to apply for this fellowship position. Please contact Joy Fuqua, Executive Director of Interactive Instruction and Innovative Delivery (Joy.Fuqua@cwu.edu), with any questions.

Process:

Email a complete application package to your department chair no later than **March 11, 2022**. The chair will forward the complete application package, with their written recommendation, via email to the appropriate dean on or before **March 18, 2022**. The dean will email the complete application package with their recommendation to the Office of the Provost no later than **April 5, 2022**. The Faculty Fellow for Excellence Committee will review the applications, via Microsoft Teams, and present a list of acceptable applications to the Provost. The Provost will review the applications and committee recommendations to make the final selection.

Application:

A complete application will consist of:

- 1) General information section (attached).
- 2) A letter or interest/personal statement outlining prior experience relating to the position's areas of focus and responsibilities (attach separately).
- 3) Endorsements (to be completed by the chair and the dean).
- 4) A complete professional CV listing appropriate research, scholarly or artistic achievements, and activities (attach separately).
- 5) Letters of support from faculty members and/or other appropriate individuals not necessarily associated with the institution (attach separately).
