2. Transfer to the ITAM program at CWU with the Edmonds Community College Associate in Arts Direct Transfer Agreement (AA-DTA).

3. Students may transfer a maximum of 135 total credits from regionally accredited four-year universities, including a maximum of 105 credits from regionally accredited community colleges.

5. Work with an Edmonds Community College faculty advisor to ensure proper course sequencing for the DTA.

7. Submit official transcripts to CWU-Ellensburg. Submit a final official transcript once your DTA is posted.

2. Completion of the BS-ITAM core requirements and one of the BS-ITAM specialization list of courses with a minimum GPA of 2.3 in ITAM coursework and a minimum grade of C- in each course.
3. Complete 180 total credits (including transfer credits) with a minimum of 60 credits in upper-division courses.
4. Review Advisement Reports regularly to check your status towards completion of all university requirements.
