  - Attend a College of Business Major Declaration Session

3. Upon completion of the DTA, apply to the major through the College of Business. Applications are available at the mandatory orientation.
4. To graduate with an accounting degree, the department requires a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in upper division accounting courses completed at CWU, in addition to the 2.25 University GPA requirements that apply to all CWU major programs. Accounting majors cannot earn a business minor.
5. A minimum of 180 quarter credits is required.
6. Review Academic Requirement Report regularly to check your status of completion of major and/or minor requirements.
