2. Students may transfer a maximum of 135 total credits from regionally accredited four-year universities, including a maximum of 105 credits from regionally accredited community colleges.

6. For full admission into the accounting program students must meet the following additional requirements:

- Completion of 30 credits (If a student is a transfer student, credits must be transferable)
- The applicant must be in good academic standing
- 2.25 Collegiate GPA
- Completion of ENG 101 and ENG 102 with a C- or higher, or equivalent
- Attend a College of Business Major Declaration Session

1. CWU- Des Moines offers students the opportunity to take course work towards their degree in Accounting, however some courses may have to be taken on the Ellensburg, or other satellite, campus for degree completion.

3. Upon completion of the DTA and foundation requirements, apply to the major through the College of Business. Applications are available at the mandatory orientation.
4. To graduate with an accounting degree, the department requires a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in upper division accounting courses completed at CWU, in addition to the 2.25 University GPA requirements that apply to all CWU major programs. Accounting majors cannot earn a business minor.
5. A minimum of 180 quarter credits is required.
6. Review Academic Requirement Report regularly to check your status of completion of major and/or minor requirements.
