Students will critically analyze the ways in which the social problems of the past affects the social problems of present and the future.		Assessment by written assignments and/or exams that critically identify the ways in which historical factors influence the present and the future. These will be assessed with a rubric anchored to a 5 point scale and 75% should achieve a satisfactory or better.	
Students will analyze the social and economic processes, issues and events thereby identifying the requirements of an informed citizenship and the impact the individual can have on social problems.		Assessment by written assignments and/or exams that demonstrate student ability to analyze a social and economic processes, issues and events. These will be assessed with a rubric anchored to a 5 point scale and 75% should achieve a satisfactory or better.
