Identify the influence of class, race and gender on social institutions and personal experience in US society.	Students will demonstrate knowledge through successful completion of written assignments, a final project and exams.
Evaluate the influences race, class and gender in his/her own family background.	Students will write a reflective essay exploring the significance of class, race and gender in the student's own family and personal relationships.
Analyze the effects of class, race and gender on specific incidents, situations or events.	Students will identify and analyze specific incidents or events that illustrate the interconnectiveness and boundaries of class, race and gender.
Recognize the influence of class, race and gender on everyday life.	Students will write an imaginary diary from the perspective of a person from another social category.
Identify the influence of class, race and gender on popular culture in the US.	Students will write an analytical essay on an example of race, class and gender as they are depicted in the media.
