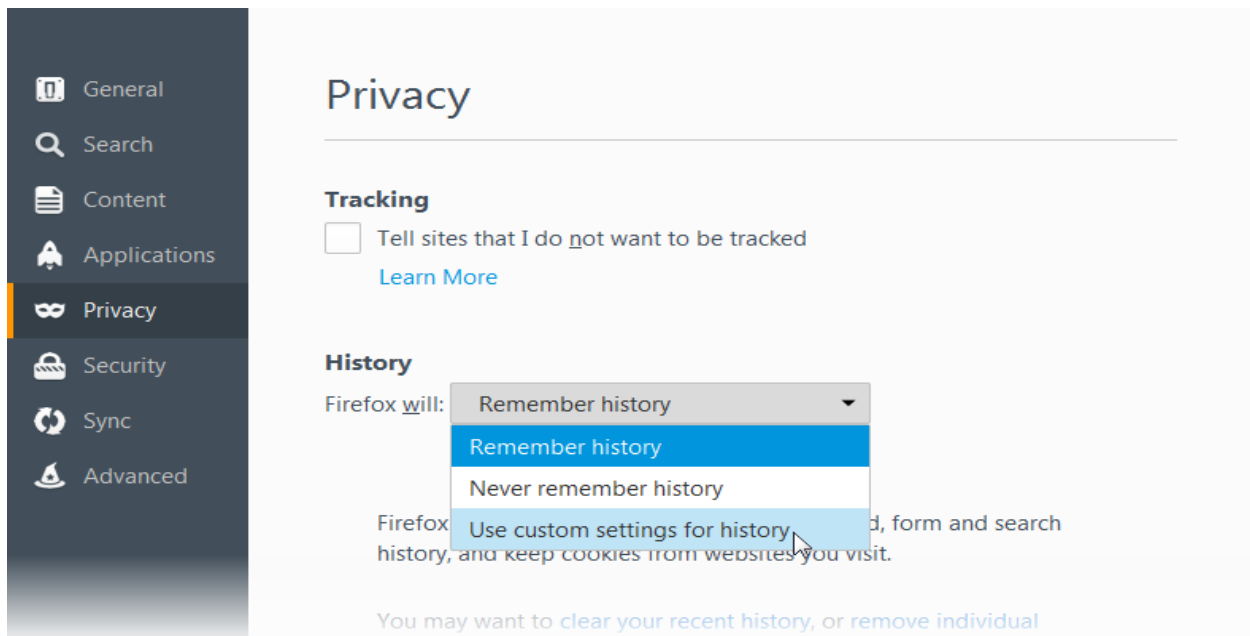
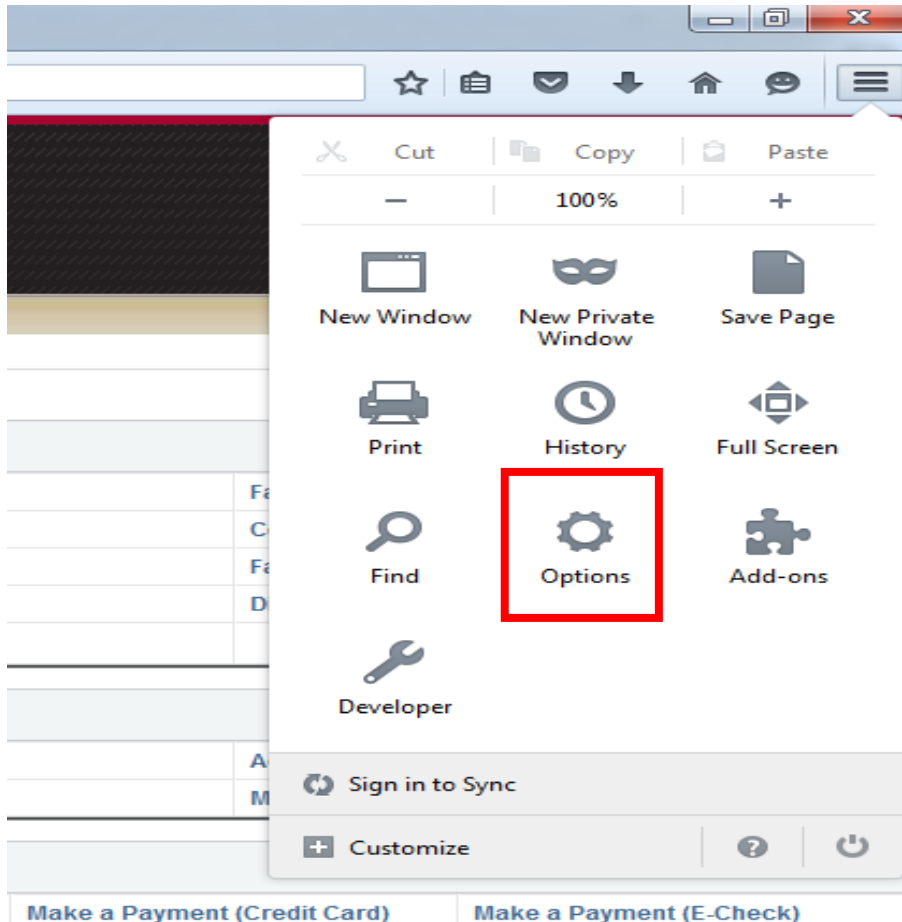

Firefox will:

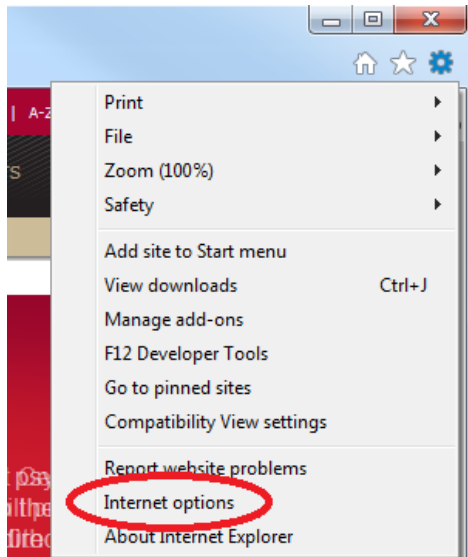
- Always use private browsing mode

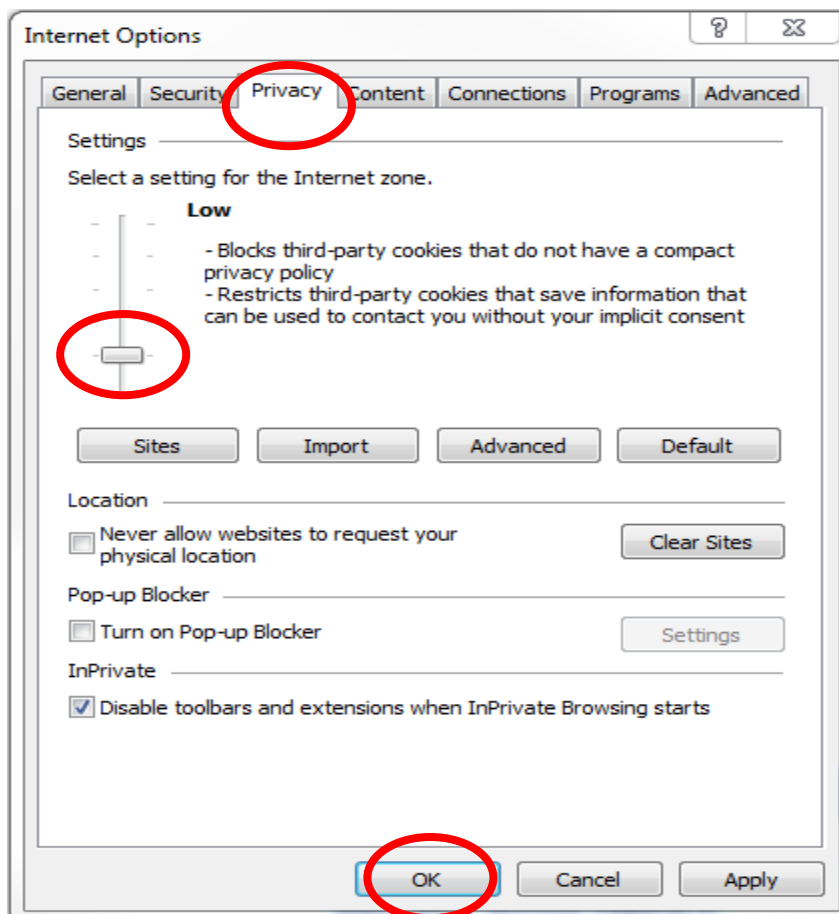

# Settings

## Default browser

## Privacy

Google Chrome may use web services to improve your browsing experience. You may optionally disable these services. [Learn more](#)

- Use a web service to help resolve navigation errors
- Use a prediction service to help complete searches and URLs typed in the address bar
- Use a prediction service to load pages more quickly
- Automatically report details of possible security incidents to Google
- Protect you and your device from dangerous sites
- Use a web service to help resolve spelling errors
- Automatically send usage statistics and crash reports to Google
- Send a "Do Not Track" request with your browsing traffic

### Content settings

#### Cookies

- Allow local data to be set (recommended)
- Keep local data only until you quit your browser
- Block sites from setting any data
- Block third-party cookies and site data

#### Images

- Show all images (recommended)
- Do not show any images

#### JavaScript

- Allow all sites to run JavaScript (recommended)
- Do not allow any site to run JavaScript

#### Handlers

- Allow sites to ask to become default handlers for protocols (recommended)
