While attending Ellensburg Normal, which would come to be Central Washington University, she enrolled in the Family and Consumer Sciences program. In the program she studied skills which prepared her for employment as a dietician at the exclusive Lakeside School in Seattle during the Depression era.

Qualification: Current Student Employees who show day in and day out their **ambitiousness, determination, sincerity and loyalty** are eligible for this award.
