Dining Services Advisory Board Constitution

Mission

The Dining Services Advisory Board is established to give the campus community input to Dining Services regarding changes to products, policy, and services that will benefit the students and general university community.

Membership

Non-Discrimination

The Dining Services Advisory Board will not discriminate in its membership on the basis of race, age, sexual orientation, gender, religion, national origin, physical disability, or marital status.

Members

Chairperson

The Chairperson for the Dining Services Advisory Board shall be elected from the voting members.

Members will represent the following groups:

The vice president of Student Life

One (1) student appointed by the RHA (on-campus)

One (1) at large BOD appointment (off-campus)

One (1) faculty member

Two (2) employees of Dining Services

One (1) advisor (Dining Services Director)

One ex-officio member will be the Dining Services Director. The only time this individual will vote is in case of a tie.

Term of Office

Chairperson

The Chairperson of the Dining Services Advisory Board shall be elected at the first meeting of each new academic year by the members.

Members

The six (6) appointed members of the Dining Services Advisory Board shall take office the meeting following their appointment by the various appointing groups. Appointments will be made during fall quarter of the year or whenever a position is vacant. Appointments will be one year in duration or, in case of a vacancy, through the beginning of Fall Quarter.

Meetings

Regular Meetings

Meetings of the Dining Services Advisory Board shall be held twice a quarter provided school is in session. The meeting dates and times shall be set by the Chairperson on a biquarterly basis.

Additional Meetings

Additional meetings will be held if the Dining Services Advisory Board Chairperson or members consider it necessary, with at least 24 hours' notice via email.

Quorum

A majority of the currently seated members of the Dining Services Advisory Board shall constitute a quorum. Quorum must be present to address voting items.
