- Transfer to the Theatre Arts-General Studies program at CWU with the Bellevue College Associate in Arts & Sciences Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA). You can complete transfer equivalencies towards your bachelor's degree while completing the requirements for the DTA.
- Students may transfer a maximum of 135 total credits from regionally accredited four-year universities, including a maximum of 105 credits from regionally accredited community colleges.

- Work with a Bellevue College advisor to ensure proper course sequencing for the DTA and Theatre Arts-General Studies major. Refer to the Bellevue Associate in Arts & Sciences degree planning guide for course selection and GPA required for graduation.
- Apply for admission to Central Washington University at www.cwu.edu/admissions. Visit your CWU advisor early in your academic career to find out if you are eligible for dual admission. Find application and guidelines at www.cwu.edu/admissions/dual-admission.
- Include official or unofficial transcripts from ALL institutions you have attended. Once your DTA is posted, have an official copy of your final transcript sent to Admissions.
- Students seeking a BA degree must complete one year of college/university study or two years of high school study of a single foreign language.
- A cumulative GPA of 2.7 in the pre-admission requirement courses must be achieved with a minimum grade of C+ (2.3) in each course.
- For students considering transferring after one year at Bellevue College, these are general education courses suggested to be completed prior to entrance into the Theatre Arts program.
- These courses are not established equivalencies with CWU; please see your CWU advisor for substitution form.
