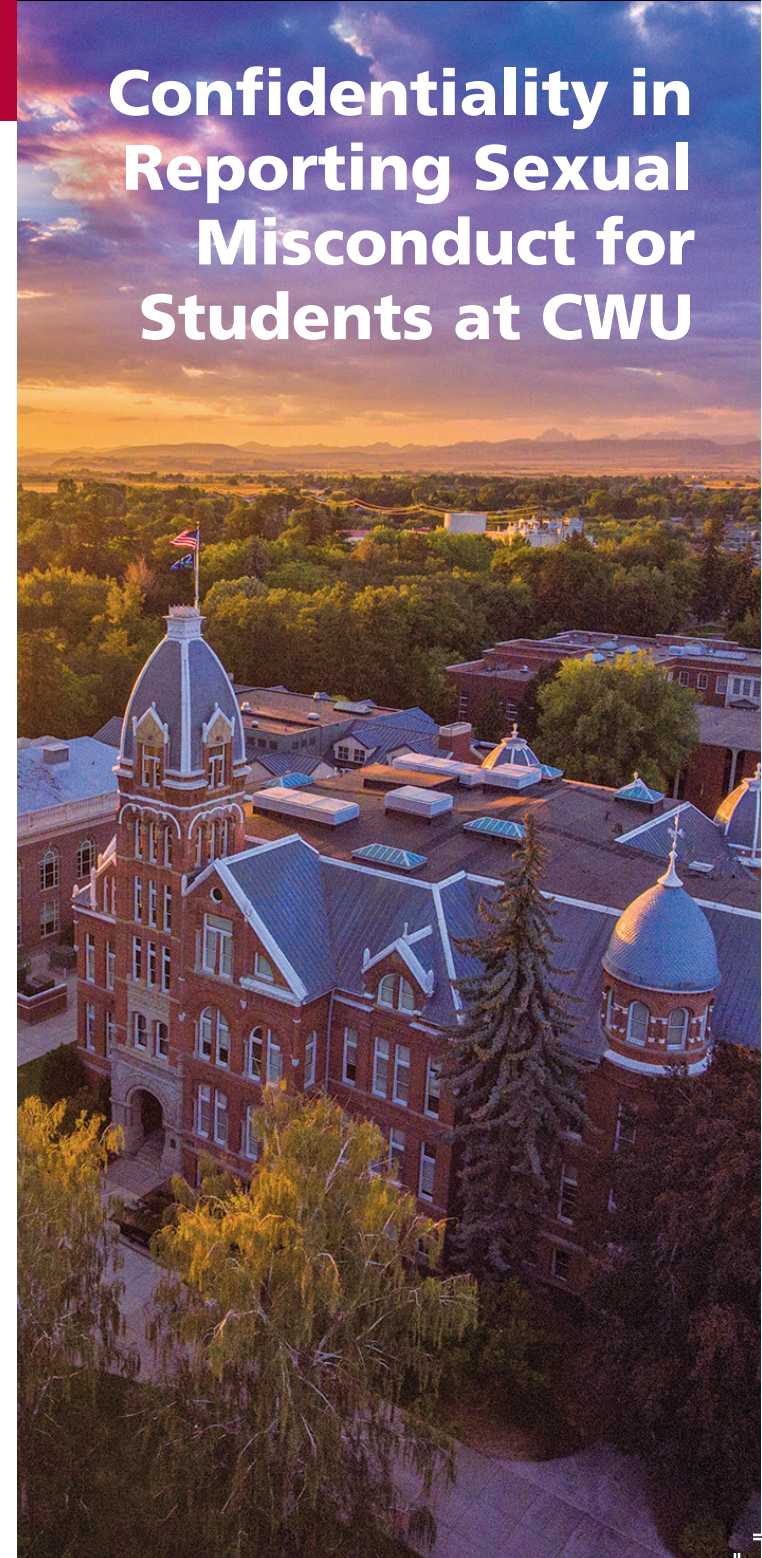

- Assists with accessing university and community resources
- Explains and assists with reporting options
- Coordinates resources, interim measures, and adjustments

- Shares information per your wishes except in situations of immediate threat or danger, or abuse of a minor or elder

COUNSELING SERVICES

- Provides information, advocacy, and support
- Supports via appointment, drop-in, or by phone
- Assists with accessing Ellensburg campus and community resources

STUDENT MEDICAL

- Provides Plan B, STI and pregnancy testing, and partner treatment
- Supports via appointment or by phone
- Assists with accessing Ellensburg campus and community resources

- Shares information as necessary, but confidentiality is not guaranteed

STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Student Conduct Investigator,

- Explains options and pursues remedies and resolutions
- Coordinates resources, interim measures, and behavior interventions
- Conducts investigations

- Conducts investigation into student behaviors of concern
- Reports information to the university Title IX Coordinator
- Takes required action in situations of acute threat to individual or community safety
- Shares information as necessary, but confidentiality is not guaranteed or possible

CWU POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Explains options and pursues remedies and resolutions
- Provides assistance, services, and safety planning
- Employs officers dedicated to sensitive response to crime

If you feel unsafe: call 911 for assistance

- Conducts investigation when you file a criminal complaint
- Reports information to the Title IX Coordinator and Director of Student Rights and Responsibilities
- Takes required action in situations of acute threat to individual or community safety
- Shares information as necessary, but confidentiality is not guaranteed or possible

OTHER RESPONSIBLE PARTIES

CWU faculty, administrators, graduate students, student employees, staff, and other designated individuals

- Offers support and directs to campus resources

- Does not investigate
- Reports information to the appropriate university official
