

# **Summary of Biological Sciences Curriculum Changes May 2008**

- 1) **Beginning Fall Quarter 2008 the introductory sequence of:  
BIOL 110 - Basic Biology  
BIOL 111 - Plant Biology  
BIOL 112 - Animal Biology  
BIOL 220 - Introductory Cellular Biology  
will be replaced with:  
BIOL 181 – General Biology I  
BIOL 182 – General Biology II  
BIOL 183 – General Biology III**
- 2) **BIOL 181, BIOL 182 and BIOL 183 will have CHEM 181, CHEM 182 and CHEM 183 as pre- or co-requisite courses. Safari will require that students register for a CHEM before registering for a BIOL course.**
- 3) **BIOL 110 will no longer be offered and Winter Quarter 2009 will be the last time that BIOL 111 and BIOL 112 will be offered .**
- 4) **BIOL 220 will continue to be offered for non-biology majors only. However, students that have taken BIOL 110, BIOL 111, and BIOL 112 should complete the sequence by taking BIOL 220 during the 2008-09 academic year.**
- 5) **BIOL 213 - Quantitative Methods in Biology is a new requirement for all biology majors and is a prerequisite for many upper division courses (e.g., BIOL 321, BIOL 323, BIOL 360)**

**Note: Currently, MATH 311 or PSY 362 can be substituted for BIOL 213 with instructor's approval.**
