## What is the "Next of Kin" Curriculum?

The NOK Curriculum is a series of two interdisciplinary science curricula, one for middle level students and the other for elementary students. Both curricula focus on information and issues dealing with free-living and captive chimpanzees. This curriculum is also designed to help prepare school groups to attend educational Chimposiums at the Chimpanzee and Human Communication Institute (CHCI) on the campus of Central Washington University (CWU) in Ellensburg, Washington. Not only will students become educated about chimpanzees but they will also be introduced to issues concerning experimentation on all animals.

## How can I use the "Next of Kin" Curriculum?

The curriculum is designed to be used either comprehensively, as a supplement, or as extra lessons as needed.

## What does the workshop entail?

We have set up a 2½-day workshop to provide participants with a foundation of knowledge, ideas and experiences regarding the "Next of Kin" curriculum and how they may use it in their classrooms. Participants will participate in activities from the curriculum and will experience both a 1-hour Chimposium and a 4½-hour Advanced Chimposium. Participants will also have the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the CD-ROM component of the curriculum. With the activities and information from this workshop, participants will leave with a better understanding of how to approach and deal with issues covered in the curriculum.

## Is the curriculum aligned with the EALRs?

The curriculum has been aligned with the Washington State Essential Academic Learning Requirements. Teachers will leave with a supplement to the curriculum identifying the various EALRs covered in the curriculum.
