Dr. Peter A. Gries, the 2009 Faculty Marshal for Eastside Commencement Ceremony One, begins the commencement procession at 9:30 a.m. sharp. Upon arriving on the platform, Dr. Gries will face the audience (West) with the University Mace. He will hold the University Mace until all participants have been seated. The Faculty Marshal will then place the mace in its stand and move to his assigned seat on the platform.

Members of the Presidential Party will be reading names, so the Deans can participate in the hooding portion of the ceremony. Before the master students receive their degrees, two faculty members will be hooding the students half-way up the ramps, so you will notice other faculty members escorting the graduate students. Some faculty will have only one student while others may have several.

The closing recessional will commence when the Alma Mater has ended and Dr. Gries picks up the mace and walks down the center aisle towards the west side of the field. The recessional is in reverse order of entry. We will not be forming a receiving line after the recessional this year, so you will follow the Silver Cortege off of the field, around the track and back to Purser Hall.
