At 6:05 p.m. the Presidential Party should form two lines outside of the Artists Lounge. There will be a staff member to guide you to the auditorium at 6:20 p.m. The ceremony begins at 6:30 p.m. sharp. The ceremony ends at approximately 8:30 p.m.

Carrying the University Mace, the Westside 2009 Faculty Marshal, Dr. Steven A. Schmitz begins the commencement procession at 6:30 p.m. sharp. Upon arriving on the platform, Dr. Schmitz will face the audience, holding the mace until all are seated. The Faculty Marshal will then place the mace in its stand and move to his assigned seat on the platform.

All members of the Presidential Party will be seated on the Benaroya Hall stage. The processional is in the following order: Faculty Marshal, Faculty, Master Candidates, Honor students, Undergraduate/Post-Bac candidates, Presidential Party. The students receiving honors or degrees will approach the platform from stage left, and exit stage right. The closing recessional will commence when Dr. Schmitz picks up the mace and walks down the center aisle. The recessional is in reverse order of entry.
